



Dear AIM Family,

In light of the Coronavirus epidemic (COVID-19), We want to assure you that we are following the appropriate agencies and their guidelines (Center of Disease Control and Prevention, World Health Organization, and local/federal health agencies). We will be diligent in keeping our patients, their families and our staff safe.

For the majority of Americans, the immediate risk from COVID-19 is being reported as low. People with compromised Immune systems and the elderly are at increased risk. We are committed as a health care office to serve our patients. We will continue to help our patients with Chiropractic, Functional Medicine and acute pain care needs as well as preventing the spread of viral infections.

The Actions we are taking:

- All staff members temperatures will be taken before each shift (am/pm).
- Our staff will be sanitizing “common touch” surfaces such as doorknobs, counter tops, and bathrooms throughout the day.
- We will be sanitizing treatment tables focusing on the head and arm rests, before each patient is seen.
- We are limiting the number of guests our patients and staff bring into the practice. We are asking that each patient come alone unless they require support during their appointment.

What we are asking of our patients:

- If you are running a fever or showing any signs of illness, please contact the office to reschedule.
- If you have traveled or are travelling outside of the country to an area impacted by the virus, we ask that you contact us before commencing or resuming a treatment plan. (if you are unsure of affected regions please check with the CDC website).
- Please practice an increased level of personal hygiene as we navigate this passing pandemic: wash your hands often with soap and water. If not available choose hand sanitizer that contains 60% or higher alcohol content. Practice coughing or sneezing into disposable tissue (dispose of immediately) or your elbow.

If you feel you have come in contact with someone who has the Corona virus or if you feel you are exhibiting the signs and symptoms associated with COVID-19 (Fever, cough, and or difficulty breathing).
